Goal:

The students will be exposed to vocabulary used in the study of the American black bear, which can be used to support letter and word recognition skills.

Curriculum Focus:

Science, Written Language, Literacy

Lesson:

Materials Needed: (Some materials are included in Black Bear Boxes)

- Large tree (either store bought or drawn on butcher paper)
- Photos to illustrate content vocabulary
- Cherry shapes with alphabet (cut out cherry shapes and label each with letters of the alphabet)
- Content word cards/pictures (create word cards using photos available in resources above)
- The ABCs of Black Bears (PowerPoint is included in Black Bear Box, link to book version above)

Background Information and Implementation:

Cherries are a favorite food of black bears. They must stretch to pull the branches down so they are able to reach the ripe cherries. Add a 'new' letter, and corresponding content word(s) (see list attached) to the display tree each week. Discuss these words throughout the week, giving students an opportunity to practice reading, writing, and understanding the words and letters in context.
